General Information

This course will count as ½ unit of elective credit, and is graded as a “PASS/FAIL Course. This credit counts toward high school graduation requirements. In order to successfully complete this course, the following criteria will be met:

- 56 hours of instruction including 12 research articles.
- Successful completion of all materials including exams, quizzes, and research articles.
- Students will need to achieve a 70% grade to pass the course.
- Must be 15 years of age to enroll.
- Length of class will be approximately 9-12 weeks.

CLASS GUIDELINES

Although Drivers Education is offered through the RISD, attendance, grading and classroom participation is different from some “regular education” courses. Parents and students need to be aware THAT COMPLETION OF THE CLASS is awarded through Traffic Safety Bureau (TSB) NOT Public Education Department (PED).

Class will be held virtually. STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ALL VIDEO MEETINGS. A DEVICE WITH A CAMERA IS NEEDED. CAMERA’S ARE REQUIRED TO BE TURNED ON AND STUDENTS VISBLE AT ALL TIMES.

THE INSTUCTOR REQUIRES TO SEE STUDENTS LIVE.

This course will satisfy requirements for Program # 2 as offered by Dept. of Transportation, State of New Mexico. This is a 56 hour virtual classroom class. All materials needed to obtain a driver’s license from the State of New Mexico will be provided. (Personal legal documents not included.)

** NO STATE DOCUMENTS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF THE CLASS.

The instructor has the right to remove ANY student for failure to complete assignments within given deadlines. We believe that driving is one the most exciting things students will learn to do in their lives. We also take this task very serious.
